### **James McFall** **Assistant General Manager, Electric Resources** **Modesto Irrigation District (MID)**



James McFall has been the Assistant General Manager of Electric Resources for Modesto Irrigation District (MID) for the last 4 years. Mr. McFall's current areas of responsibility include electric generation, transmission and distribution switching, long and short-term planning and procurement of power and natural gas, and legislative and regulatory review and compliance (including NERC Reliability Standards and California's renewable and greenhouse gas initiatives). Mr. McFall began his career at MID in 1990 in resource planning before moving on to power operations, where he subsequently assumed a leadership role. McFall has since held supervisory and management level positions for the past 22 years.

Mr. McFall has also served as Chairman for the Commission of the Transmission Agency of Northern California, President for the Commission of the MSR Public Power Agency, and as an Alternate Commissioner of BANC. Mr. McFall holds a Bachelor of Science in Mathematics from the University of California, Riverside.
