### **Michelle Bertolino** **Electric Director** **City of Roseville**



Michelle Bertolino was named Electric Utility Director in 2010. The City of Roseville is unique to the Sacramento region in that it owns and operates its own electric utility. Michelle has worked for the City of Roseville since 2002.

Ms. Bertolino oversees a \$165 million budget and over 150 employees who are responsible for generation and distribution of electricity to about 60,000 residential and business customers. Roseville Electric operates two power plants, including the Roseville Energy Park, a 160 megawatt natural gas, combined cycle power plant.

Prior to becoming Roseville Electric's Director, Ms. Bertolino held the position of Assistant Utility Director, overseeing demand side management, rate development, customer service, public relations, financial forecasting and budgeting for the utility. She also managed the Distribution business unit and was responsible for electric operations, construction, maintenance, engineering, and dispatch services for the utility.

Prior to Roseville, Ms. Bertolino worked for the Sacramento Municipal Utility District, San Francisco Public Utilities Commission, and KPMG Peat Marwick.

Ms. Bertolino attended the University of California at Davis, Graduate School of Management and completed her undergraduate studies at the University of California at Santa Barbara.
