Michelle Bertolino **Electric Director,** **City of Roseville**



Michelle Bertolino was named the cities Electric Utility Director in May 2010. The City of Roseville is unique to the Sacramento region in that it owns and operates its own utility. Michelle has worked for the City of Roseville since 2002.

Michelle oversees a \$163 million budget and 137 employees who are responsible for generation and distribution of electricity to about 55,000 residential and business customers. Roseville Electric operates two power plants, including the Roseville Energy Park, a 160 megawatt natural gas, combined cycle power plant.

Prior to becoming Roseville Electric's Director, Michelle has held the position of Assistant Utility Director, overseeing demand side management, rate development, customer service, public relations, financial forecasting and budgeting for the utility. Michelle also managed the Distribution business unit and was responsible for electric operations, construction, maintenance, engineering and dispatch services for the utility.

Prior to Roseville, Michelle worked for the Sacramento Municipal Utility District, San Francisco Public Utilities Commission and KPMG Peat Marwick.

Michelle attended the University of California at Davis, Graduate School of Management and completed her undergraduate studies at the University of California at Santa Barbara.
