Tom Miller is the electric utility director for the City of Shasta Lake, and oversees the municipal's electric utility enterprise. Miller works with the city manager and city council to establish and carry out the plans, policies, and annual budgets of the city's electric utility. The electric enterprise is the City of Shasta Lake's largest service, with expenditures greater than \$20M annually. The electric utility is a load serving entity and distribution provider for 4,500 connections covering ten square miles.

Since 2012, Miller has also served as the assistant city manager for the City. In addition to the electric utility, the assistant city manager duties include personnel, animal control, the City's motor pool, and special assignments.

Miller has over 20 year experience in retail electric distribution working for smaller rural electric cooperatives in Iowa. He held a variety of positions serving as chief executive officer, assistant manager, administrative and customer service manager, and director of economic development. Tom earned a Bachelor of Arts degree from Central College, Pella, Iowa, double majoring in systems and business management.
